## **Calendar for Program**

- Start week of 9/11
- Fall Break 11/20-11/24
- Winter Break 12/18 1/2 (No class Monday or Tuesday, Jan. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>)
- Spring Break 4/1 4/5
- End the week before Memorial Day (last day is 5/24)

Approximately 31-34 weeks of classes running between Labor Day and Memorial Day (depending on snow days, etc). We also have summer camp and summer private lesson options for those interested (scheduled later in the spring). We will schedule concerts for in person classes seasonally based on Covid-19 issues, etc. at the time but the earliest would be possibly the 1<sup>st</sup> week in December (TBD). Some classes may do small performances during class time during the year.

**Ensembles meet once a week\***. Ensembles meet for 50-55\* minutes (it's fast paced to keep them interested!)

\* Some classes may meet for a different length of time to suit student/parent needs.

• In-Person Classes Monthly: \$50 a month (sibling and multiple class discounts available)

Online Classes Monthly: \$40 each per immediate family household

• Private Lessons\* Weekly: \$20/half hour. Please pay beginning of month if possible

\* Private lessons will be at my home in Centerville or on Zoom Wednesday – Friday or at Dayton Dance Conservatory in Huber Heights on Mondays unless otherwise worked out. Students taking private lessons may be eligible to also attend a class for free if lessons are paid at the beginning of each month at \$80/month (other discounts do not apply).

The program can include grades and evidence of standards met and individual growth if needed. Possibly Credit Flex too (alternate course credit) for students enrolled in public schools.
